## Rules

In order to ensure the safety and comfort of our guests and to maintain the public nature of the inn, we have established the following rules, which are integrated with the accommodation contract. If these rules are violated, the accommodation contract may be cancelled in accordance with the provisions of Article 4 of the accommodation contract.

- 1. The following behaviors are strictly prohibited in the inn.
  - (1) Use of rooms by persons in excess of the contracted number of guests
  - (2) Smoking in the room (including smoking of electronic cigarettes, heated tobacco products, etc.)
  - (3) Attempts to bring pets into the room
- (4) Bringing in items that may ignite or catch fire, interfere with the sanitation of the inn, are prohibited by law or ordinance, and/or cause harm or discomfort to employees, residents, and neighbors
- (5) Taking parts of the building or equipment home, moving them, using them for purposes other than their intended use, and/or intentionally damaging them
  - (6) Leaving personal belongings outside of the guest room
  - (7) Unauthorized harvesting and/or taking home of vegetables, fruit trees, etc., managed by the inn on the premises
  - (8) Engaging in any commercial activities without the permission of the inn
  - (9) Acts that are extremely inconsiderate to employees, residents, and neighbors, such as loud and boisterous behavior
- (10) Use of the wood stove, furnace, and brazier that require fire management without the permission and guidance of staff
  - (11) Other acts that go against public order and morals, or that interfere with the safety and sanitation of the inn
- 2. Please notify us as soon as possible if a part of the building, any fixtures, etc., have been dirtied or damaged for any reason, so that we can properly preserve the building.
